Lamine Barro is a sculptor, painter and ceramist. He lives and works in Dakar, at the Cité des Arts. He is, incontestably, the face of Senegalese art in the world.

His early pieces are exhibited in Dakar in 1982, the two following years will be marked by a theme around apartheid (PANA) presented especially during the Intergovernmental Council of Ministers of Information, which took place in 1984. He participated in Shows at the National Plastic Artists (ANAPS), which he will be appointed Treasurer General two years later.

Many exhibitions followed such as those for the International Foundation for Culture and Arts Africans BIAO) (1985), the Embassy of the United States in Dakar (1985); The International Forum and Inter Cultural "Symbiosis", Sagem, Chana Club which will run in France (Paris, Toulouse Cergy, Osny, ...) (1986), he represented the National Association of Artists at the Biennale of Algiers (1986). He is present also in Saarbrucken former FRG, in Vancouver, Canada and Rome (1986), Austria (1986), the United States (1990), Brazil and Argentina (1991), he becomes more and more the face of the Senegalese contemporary Art around the world "(1991).

Lamine Barro is seen at major exhibitions at the National Gallery in (1991) and (1996), where the government of Senegal bought nearly 40 of his paintings.

After his previous exhibition at the National Gallery of Arts (1996), he entirely devotes himself to the achievement of sculptures whose title is "Goree, on the Slave Route, from memory to Pardon". It took him five years of work to make 1750 figurines, in collaboration with Professor Mbaye Gueye, University Cheikh Anta Diop, for historical accuracy; five years to making sure of the details of each of the characters, faces, costumes, accessories, m² (2000-2005). He is a permanent exhibitor at the IFAN Museum.
